	PRECAUTIONS	ROM	EXERCISES
Phase 1: 0-2 weeks 2x/week	Sling x 2 weeks	No elbow ROM	Hand and wrist AROM exs
	Avoid Pronation/ Supination	No forearm ROM	
	No lifting	Full hand and wrist ROM	
Phase 2: 2-4 weeks 2x/week	D/C Sling	Elbow Flex/Ext as tolerated	Hand, wrist exs;
	No lifting >1# with ADL's	Protect Pronation/ Supination	Elbow Flexion / Elbow Extension AROM
			Can begin soft tissue work
Phase 3: 4-6 weeks 2x/week	No lifting >5# with ADL's	No elbow ROM restrictions	Continue above exs
	ADLS	Gentle Pronation/ Supination	Scar mobilization
Phase 4: 6-12 weeks 2x/week	Ease restrictions	Full	Initiate elbow/forearm strengthening exercises 1#
			Work up to "75%" of normal activity levels
Phase 5: 12-16 weeks 1-2x/week	No restrictions	Full	Expect "90%" activity levels at 4 months post-op
			Return to full duty > 4 months

If graft is used, stay in each phase +1 week for healing and protection
